Marsha and Terri have received 50 hours of specialized training in Christian caregiving and join a team of eleven Stephen Ministers and Leaders serving our congregation and community.

Stephen Ministers meet weekly with their care receiver for about an hour to listen, care, encourage, pray, and provide emotional and spiritual support. Caring relationships last for as long as the person's need persists.

Prayer Walk for Community

Step out in faith this fall and make a real difference for Wethersfield. We are planning to walk through three Wethersfield neighborhoods, pray for the residents, connect with them by bringing them gifts of home-baked cookies and fresh produce, and ask if we can pray for them over the next few months.

Put legs to your prayers! On the **Sundays of September 15 and 29, and October 13**, we will walk through three pre-selected areas and pray for the residents, starting with lunch at First Church, in the Drawing Room at 12:30, then a short training, and prayer.

Each team will have three volunteers. One person will deliver gifts door-to-door and ask the residents for their prayer requests, and two volunteers will pray quietly for each home. Residents will be asked to share an email address for continued prayer updates. This allows us to follow up and make a deeper connection with those who are interested.

We also need volunteers who will bake cookies as gifts or share fresh produce from their gardens. Another group of volunteers is needed to provide sandwiches and drinks for those participating in the three Prayer Walks.

This ministry can involve many of us in the church. Even if you never leave your home, you can still take part in reaching out to our community!

As you know, we are trying to cultivate an environment that will help 300 new people embark on their journey of discipleship within the next three years. Reaching out with love

and prayer to our neighbors is one of the steps we can take.

The Prayer Walks will help us connect with our community and also to follow up those connections by an invitation to Alpha. To coordinate with *Prayer Walk for Community*, we will offer our next Alpha course early in 2014, with the hope that some of our neighbors for whom we pray will wish to participate.
