

## *Circle of Prayer*

**Protection, and Consecration** of First Church of Christ to:  
God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

As we begin our walk, we begin by re-consecrating the ground to the Lord. “I proclaim this ground has been consecrated to God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, and ask legions of heavenly angels to protect First Church and all the congregation.” We seek Your face, O Lord, and ask Your Presence to rest upon us.

**Petitions** would include (in present tense, to acknowledge this agreement with heaven):

We stand in full agreement with Heaven that:

1. First Church is expanding the Kingdom of God.
2. The Lord is bringing forth multitudes of new believers.
3. Lost souls are being led to salvation through Jesus Christ.
4. A hunger and thirst for the love and mercy of Christ has been given to our community
5. That First Church is provided with divine guidance on how to feed this hunger and quench this thirst supernaturally.
6. We proclaim that the Holy Spirit dwells among us and brings His gifts of the Spirit—wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miraculous, prophecy, tongues, interpretation (1 Corinthians 12: 4-11). We pray to have our hearts readied to receive.

Move into a period of **thankfulness**—thanking God for miracles/favor yet to occur.

1. Thank you Lord, for the favor of donations exceeding the \$2.5 million goal.
2. Thank you Lord, for speaking to the hearts of the congregation to give generously.
3. Thank you Lord, for an on-time, on-budget completion of the Marsh 2.0 building campaign.

### **Scriptures: from the “Sword of the Spirit”**

1. Thank you, Lord, that You will supply all of their needs according to Your riches in glory, in the Name of Jesus (Philippians 4:19).
2. Thank you, Lord, that You will put Your foot on all the necks of their enemies, in the Name of Jesus Christ (Joshua 10:25).
3. Thank You that it is You, Lord, who blesses the righteous man, You surround him as with a shield (Psalm 5:12).
4. Thank You that the Spirit of the Lord will rest upon us—the Spirit of wisdom, understanding, counsel, strength, knowledge, and the fear of the Lord; in the Name of Jesus Christ (Isaiah 11:2).
5. Thank You, Lord, that you desire truth in their innermost being; and in their hidden part, You will make them know wisdom (Psalm 51:6).
